

## CHAPTER V

### CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

This chapter of this thesis based on the result of the findings and interpretation in Chapter IV. This chapter contains two parts, such as conclusion and suggestions.

#### A. Conclusion

Based on the findings and interpretation on this study, the writer concluded that in the BBC News Articles in November 2023 there were 268 coordinating conjunction. There are seven coordinating conjunction that have been discovered, namely *For*, *And*, *Nor*, *But*, *Or*, *Yet*, and *So*. The coordinating conjunction "*for*" is used to join two phrases in which there is 1 and two independent clauses in which there are 5. Therefore, all of them in which there are 6. The coordinating conjunction "*and*" is used to join two individual words in which there are 31, three individual words in which there are 2, four individual words in which there is 1, two phrases in which there are 64, three phrases in which there are 17, four phrases in which there are 3, six phrases in which there is 1, two independent clauses in which there are 66, and three independent clauses in which there is 1. Thus, in which there are a total of 186. The coordinating conjunction "*nor*" in which there is only 1, namely it is used to join two independent clauses. The coordinating conjunction "*but*" is used to join two independent clauses in which there are 45. The coordinating conjunction "*or*" is used to join two individual words in which there are 3, three

individual words in which there are 4, two phrases in which there are 5, three phrases in which there is 1, and two independent clauses in which there are 5. Therefore, all of them in which there are 18. The coordinating conjunction “*yet*” is used to join two independent clauses in which there are 2 and the coordinating conjunction “*so*” is used to join two independent clauses in which there are 10. Based on these data it can be concluded that the coordinating conjunction applied in the entertainment and art column on the BBC News Articles in November 2023 are dominant to coordinating conjunction “*and*” while the least frequently found is coordinating conjunction “*nor*”.

## **B. Suggestions**

Based on the conclusion above, the writer would give some suggestions as follows:

### **1. For students**

The results of this study can increase knowledge about conjunction, especially coordinating conjunction. The writer also suggest the students can learn in direct practice how to use coordinating conjunction correctly in speaking and writing.

### **2. For the lecturer**

The writer suggest that lecturers can read this study and be able to understand coordinating conjunction. Hence, the lecturer can apply it in learning to find coordinating conjunction in the news.

### 3. For the future researchers

The writer recommends that further studies can be more in-depth and broader in analyzing conjunction. Hence, the writer suggest that new researchers who are interested in analyzing conjunctions have a broader knowledge in using different source of data and theories, for example types of conjunction in movie script, songs, novels, etc. Thus, the writer hopes that readers can provide corrections to this study so that it can be used as learning material to conduct good research.
