

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

This chapter consists of conclusion and suggestions, the writer concludes based on the findings and interpretation and gives some suggestions to the reader.

A. Conclusion

Based on the findings and discussion, the writer concludes as follows:

1. Compounding refers to the combination of two or more words to create a new meaning. Thus, analyzing the process of compounding to create a new word might help in expanding the vocabulary when learning a foreign language, particularly in English. It completely confirms the three types of compound words identified in Maudy Ayunda's post on Instagram. These types include compound adjectives, compound noun, and compound verbs. Compound adjectives are formed through noun-adjective, adjective-adjective, and preposition-adjective, compound nouns are formed through noun-noun, verb-noun, adjective-noun, and preposition-noun. Compound verbs are formed through verb-verb, noun-verb, adjective-verb, and preposition-verb.
2. The writer identifies compound words based on McCarthy (2018: 61) theory. The writer finds 49 words which are classified into 25 words as headed compound, 24 words as headless compound, and three types of

compound words, with detail 3 compound adjectives such as *heartwarming, one-sided, and wholesome*. 43 compound nouns for instance *booklist, milestone, weekend, insight, necklace, and hair mask*. Then, 3 compound verbs includes *overlook, self-publish, and intimate*. Another example is provided in data findings. Based on explanation above, the type of compound word which is more dominates is compound noun.

B. Suggestions

Based on the conclusion above, the writer gives several suggestions to the readers:

The results of the study can increase knowledge about vocabulary of students who want to learn compound words and the types of compound words that may occur in the learning process or everyday language.
