CHAPTER I

Fishman in Febrianty 2019: 49). Another definition according to Holmes (2018: 1), Sociolinguistics is a studies about the relationship between language and society. They interests in explaining why we speak differently in different social context, and they concern with identifying the social functions of language and the way it uses to convey social meaning. From the definitions we can conclude that Sociolinguistics is a science that studies language and the use of language in society along with its language variations.

Language variation is a characteristic of language which it uses to convey the same thing but using different language. Speakers may vary in pronunciation (accent), word choice (lexicon), or Morphology and Syntax (sometimes called "grammar"). Barzan and Heydari (2019: 2) state that the term linguistic variation (or simply variation) refers to regional, social, or contextual

differences in the way a particular language use which it plays an important role in the use of language variations. one of languages variations is slang.

Slang is unconventional words or phrases that express either something new or something old in a new way (Maurer, 2023: 1). It is flippant, irreverent, indecorous; it may be indecent or obscene. Its colorful metaphors are generally direct at respectability, and it is this succinct, sometimes witty, frequently persistent social criticism that gives slang its characteristic flavour. Allan and Burridge (2018: 20) state that slang is a marker of a group of people. Examples are communities that share experiences such as belonging to a particular group of children at a particular school, belonging to a particular social group such as prostitutes, addicts, jazz musicians, or professional criminals.

Comes from the definition above it can conclude that slang reflects the conditions of a social group, slang is unconventional language that use words or phrases that express something new or something old in a new way, sometimes creating new vocabulary, and people usually think that slang is mostly used by teenagers. Slang words can find in film products originating from America as the mecca of world cinema/Movie.
