Ketentuan Pidana

Pasal 113:

1. Setiap Orang yang dengan tanpa hak melakukan pelanggaran hak ekonomi sebagaimana dimaksud dalam Pasal 9 ayat (1) huruf i untuk Penggunaan Secara Komersial dipidana dengan pidana penjara paling lama 1 (satu) tahun dan/atau pidana denda paling banyak Rp 100.000.000,- (seratus juta rupiah).

Buku ajar ini disusun dengan mengacu pada referensi ilmiah dan studi kasus yang relevan, baik dari dalam negeri maupun mancanegara. Pembahasan difokuskan tidak hanya pada teori-teori utama seperti primordialisme, konstruktivisme, dan instrumentalisme, tetapi juga pada isu-isu kontemporer seperti hak-hak minoritas, konflik etnis, peran organisasi internasional, serta pengaruh globalisasi terhadap identitas budaya.

Saya menyadari bahwa buku ini masih jauh dari sempurna. Oleh karena itu, saya sangat mengharapkan kritik dan saran dari para pembaca demi perbaikan dan penyempurnaan di masa mendatang.

Fany Anggun Abadi adalah dosen muda di Hubungan Internasional, Universitas Peradaban, Bumiayu. Ia menyelesaikan studi sarjana di jurusan Hubungan Internasional Universitas Peradaban pada tahun 2021, dan melanjutkan pendidikan magister pada program Pascasarjana Hubungan Internasional di Universitas Muhammadiyah Yogyakarta, lulus pada tahun 2023.

Ketertarikannya terhadap isu-isu strategis global, regionalisme, dan dinamika kelompok minoritas menjadikannya aktif dalam kegiatan akademik dan publikasi ilmiah. Ia pernah menulis dan menerbitkan berbagai artikel di jurnal bereputasi nasional, antara lain terkait Indo-Pacific Economic Framework, peran Organisasi Kerjasama Islam (OKI) dalam konflik Palestina, dan isu perdagangan anak dalam kerja sama Indonesia-ECPAT. Selain itu, ia juga menjadi kontributor dalam sejumlah buku kolaboratif bertema globalisasi, komunikasi profetik, dan hubungan internasional kontemporer.
